## FAIR DEMAND AT IRREGULARLY EASIER RATES FOLLOWING QUALITY

### **HIGH GROWN TEAS**

**BOP** 

Best Western's where quality was maintained, gained Rs. 10/- per kg. Others were irregular and mostly lower following quality. In the below best category too a few brighter invoices were Rs. 5-10/- per kg dearer whilst the others together with the plainer sorts declined Rs. 15-30/- per kg. Nuwara Eliya's declined Rs. 20-30/- per kg and substantially more following quality. Uva/Udapussellawa's declined Rs. 20-30/- per kg and more following quality.

**BOPF** 

Best Western's where quality was maintained were firm with a few select invoices appreciating in value following special inquiry. Teas in the below best category declined Rs. 20/- per kg and more following quality. Plainer sorts declined Rs. 10/- per kg. Nuwara Eliya's-a few select invoices were dearer following special inquiry whilst the others were Rs.10-15/- per kg lower. Udapussellawa's declined Rs. 20-30/- per kg and more following quality. Uva's declined Rs. 20/- per kg and more following quality.

## UNORTHODOX TEAS(CTC)

HIGH GROWN BP1s – Rs. 10/- per kg dearer. PF1s – Clean leaf coloury teas-barely steady. Others were irregular and declined Rs. 10-20/- per kg.

MEDIUM GROWN BP1s – Irregular. PF1s – Clean leaf coloury teas- firm. Others were irregular and mostly easier.

#### OFF GRADES

#### FGS1/FGS

Best liquorings in the High & Medium category were dearer by Rs. 15-20/per kg whilst cleaner below best varieties were dearer Rs.10-15/- per kg.
Others too gained Rs. 20-25/- and more at times. Low Growns were dearer
Rs. 5-10/- per kg. Best CTC's were dearer Rs. 10-15/- per kg. whilst below
best and poorer sorts were firm to Rs. 5/- per kg dearer.

#### **DUSTS**

#### **DUST1**

Select best primaries were firm to irregularly lower. Few High Grown DUST1's in the best category sold at last levels. Balance along with the below best varieties declined Rs.25-30/- per kg and more. Poorest on offer declined further. Best Medium's declined Rs.30-35/- per kg. others declined further. Best CTC's declined Rs.25-30/- per kg. Few below best varieties sold at last levels. Balance along with the poorer sorts declined Rs. 25-30/- per kg and were mostly discounted. Low Growns sold at last levels. Below best declined Rs10-15/- per kg. Poorest on offer declined further.

#### **DUST**

Clean secondaries declined Rs15-20/- per kg. Below best gained Rs. 5-10/- per kg. Poorest on offer were dearer by Rs. 10-15/- and more. CTC's declined Rs. 15-20/-per kg. Better Low Growns declined Rs. 5-10/- per kg. Poorer sorts declined further.

#### LOW GROWN TEAS

## FBOP/ FBOP1

Few select best FBOP's firm to dearer. Balance together with best firm. Cleaner below best too sold around last level. However the bolder type declined. Cleaner teas at the bottom firm. Others irregular. FBOP1's in general irregular.

**BOP** 

Select best sold around last level. Best easier. Below best and the teas at the bottom declined.

BOP1

A range of better BOP1's together with clean below best held firm. Others were irregular and lower. At the lower end prices were firm.

**OP1** 

Better OP1's together with clean below best were firm. Others were lower following quality. At the lower end cleaner types were fully firm. Balance were barely steady.

**OP** 

Better OP's were firm to selectively dearer. Others were barely steady following quality. At the lower end prices were firm to irregularly lower.

**OPA** 

Better OPA's were fully firm to dearer. Others were irregular and marginally easier. At the lower end prices were marginally lower.

**PEKOE** Better PEK/PEK1's were fully firm to irregularly dearer. Others particularly the

bold types gained Rs.10-20/- per kg and more. Balance were fully firm to

irregularly dearer.

**BOPF** Few select best firm. Others easier.

FBOPF1

Very Tippy teas continue to attract good demand. Best firm. Balance declined.

Select best and best FBOPF1's firm to dearer. Balance lower.
