## **HIGH GROWN TEAS**

**BOP** 

Best Western's declined Rs. 10/- per kg on average. In the below best category a selection of brighter teas gained Rs. 10-15/- per kg-others declined by similar margin whilst the plainer sorts were irregular and barely steady. Nuwara Eliya's were mostly unsold. Udapussellawa's were irregular following quality. Clean leaf Uva's gained Rs. 10-20/- per kg whilst the others were irregular.

**BOPF** 

Best Western's-select invoices gained Rs. 10-20/- per kg. Others were irregular. In the below best category clean leaf brighter liquoring teas gained Rs. 10-15/- per kg whilst the others were sold around last week's levels. Plainer sorts gained Rs. 10/- per kg and more for a selection of improved teas. Nuwara Eliya's declined up to Rs. 20/- per kg. Uva/Udapussellawa's gained Rs. 10-20/- per kg.

## **UNORTHODOX TEAS(CTC)**

<u>HIGH</u> GROWN

BP1s - Sold around last week's levels. PF1s - Sold around last week's levels

MEDIUM GROWN BP1s – Firm and tended dearer. PF1s – Clean leaf coloury teas were Rs. 5-10/-per kg dearer. Others were irregular.

## OFF GRADES

#### FGS1/FGS

Best liquorings in the High & Medium category were firm on last whilst below best varieties commenced firm and declined Rs.15-20/- per kg towards the closure of the sale. Poorer sorts too were easier Rs.10-15/- per kg and more at times. Low Growns in general were firm on last week level. Best CTC's dearer Rs.5-10/- per kg whilst below best varieties were substaintally dearer. Poorer sorts were irregular.

#### **DUSTS**

#### **DUST1**

Select best primaries and few DUST1's in the best category gained Rs.10-20/-per kg following special inquiry. Balance along with the below best declined Rs.15-20/- per kg and more. Poorest on offer declined further. Few Medium's gained Rs.10-15/- per kg following quality. Balance sold at last level. Better CTC's were firm to irregularly lower. Below best varieties were dearer by Rs.10-15/- per kg following quality. Balance along with the poorer sorts declined by a similar margin. Best Low Growns were irregular and mostly lower. Cleaner below best varieties gained Rs 5-10/- per kg and more. Poorer sorts sold at last level.

#### **DUST**

Clean secondaries sold at last levels. Below best declined Rs.5-10/- per kg. Poorer sorts were firm to irregularly dearer. CTC's were irregular and mostly lower. Better Low Growns sold at last level. Poorer sorts declined Rs.10-20/per kg and more.

### LOW GROWN TEAS

FBOP/	Select best FBOP's declined. Cleaner below and teas at the bottom were firm.
FBOP1	Select best FBOP1's were easier. Balance firm.

- **BOP** A few select best BOP's were firm. Others declined.
- **BOP1** Select best BOP1's were barely steady. Others and teas at the lower end were fully firm to selectively dearer.
- <u>OP1</u> A few select best were firm to dearer. Other high priced teas were barely steady following quality. Improved/ clean below best were firm. Balance were barely steady.
- **OP** A selection of best/ improved below best were firm to dearer. Others were barely steady.
- <u>OPA</u>
  Select best together with the improved below best were firm. Others were irregular and lower Rs. 5-10- per kg.

**PEKOE** PEK1's together with better PEK's were firm to dearer. Others particularly the

bolder PEK's declined by Rs. 5-10/- per kg and more as the sale progressed.

**BOPF** Except for a few select best invoices, all others were easier.

Select best and best FBOPF1's declined by Rs. 10-15/- per kg. Balance too were

lower and at times unsellable. Very tippy teas declined. Balance too were lower,

however, a few leafier invoices maintained.
